born at Thornton's Ferry A.D. 1800.

"After honorably filling various posts under the state and national government, he died at Callao, A.D. 1838, while representing the United States as "Charge d'affaires to Peru."

"His remains were removed to this spot by his son and interred A.D. 1871."

"A memory of his merits still lives where he once lived and records his parise."
